# OGUN ASSEMBLY COMMENDS ABIODUN FOR RECONSTRUCTING ROAD ABANDONED FOR 23 YEARS AT WATERSIDE LG

The Speaker of the Ogun State House of Assembly, Rt. Hon. Olakunle Oluomo has lauded the State Governor, Prince Dapo Abiodun for the rehabilitation of Ibiade General Hospital and the recent flagging off of the Togbunrin / Agodo / Lukogbe / Tigara road in Ogun Waterside Local Government which has been abandoned for over 23 years.

This was just as the Speaker sought for more of such developmental projects including road construction and rehabilitation as well as upgrade of health facilities to all the twenty-six State Constituencies.

Oluomo gave the commendation while responding to the submission of his Deputy, Akeem Balogun, who spoke under Personal Explanation intimating his colleague-lawmakers on the infrastructural intervention by the Prince Dapo Abiodun led administration in his constituency at the Assembly Complex, Oke-Mosan, Abeokuta.

Balogun stressed that the renovation of the health facility had improved residents' easy access to qualitative health facility, while the road rehabilitation would help ease human and vehicular movements in the area. In another development, the State Assembly has called for an increased



advocacy and sponsorship from elected officials and public office holders to assist more residents of the State enroll for the just launched State Health Insurance Scheme.

Speaker Oluomo, who made the call while replying to the admonition of a member representing Yewa North 1 State Constituency, Hon. Adegboje Adeyanju, who assured that he would register 112 members of his constituency in the scheme.

Calling on his colleague lawmakers and other public spirited individuals to support the less privileged to get enrolled on the health insurance scheme, Oluomo stated that the step would assist at increasing enrollment of people through the payment of their premium to enable them benefit from the health coverage programme.

## Her Majesty, Queen Josephine Diete-Spiff licensed as Lay reader in Anglican Communion, Niger Delta Diocese

The Anglican Communion, Niger Diocese under the spiritual leadership of His Grace, Bishop Ralph Ebirien licensed Her Majesty, Queen Dame Josephine Diete-Spiff JP as Layreader. Reacting to the honour bestowed on Her Royal Majesty, She said "Join me to pray that this auction will enlarge the Kingdom of God positively and assist me thank God for finding me worthy."

A licensed lay minister or lay reader is a person authorized by a bishop in the Anglican Communion to lead certain services of worship, to preach, and to carry out pastoral and teaching functions. They are formally trained and admitted to office, but they remain part of the laity, not of the clergy.

Anglican lay Reader are licensed by the bishop to a particular parish or to the diocese at large.

The vast majority of lay Reader are volunteers.

The role, whose prominence varies by region, bears many similarities to both the traditional liturgical role of Reader in the historic catholic rites of the church, and the role of lay preacher found in many non-conformist denominations.

The role can involve Conducting the Daily Office (Mattins, Evensong, Compline) or other non-sacramental services, Reciting the Litany

Publishing banns of marriage, Preaching, teaching, and assisting in pastoral care Distributing (though not presiding at) Holy Communion.

Participation at other services as requested by their incumbent in some cases the role may include conducting funerals.

In many parishes a lay reader may carry out liturgical functions at the eucharist similar to the role of the liturgical deacon; in parishes of anglo-catholic tradition, a lay reader may vest and act as subdeacon at solemn mass.

Many of these duties can be performed by any reasonably competent lay person who has been properly instructed, but a lay reader is licensed to perform them as part of a wider leadership role, following extensive training.

This training and licensing elevates the reader to a particular ministerial role and function recognised as being distinct from the parish-based lay leadership of local congregational volunteers.

Their theological training enables them to preach, teach, and lead worship, and they are also able to assist in pastoral, evangelistic and liturgical work.



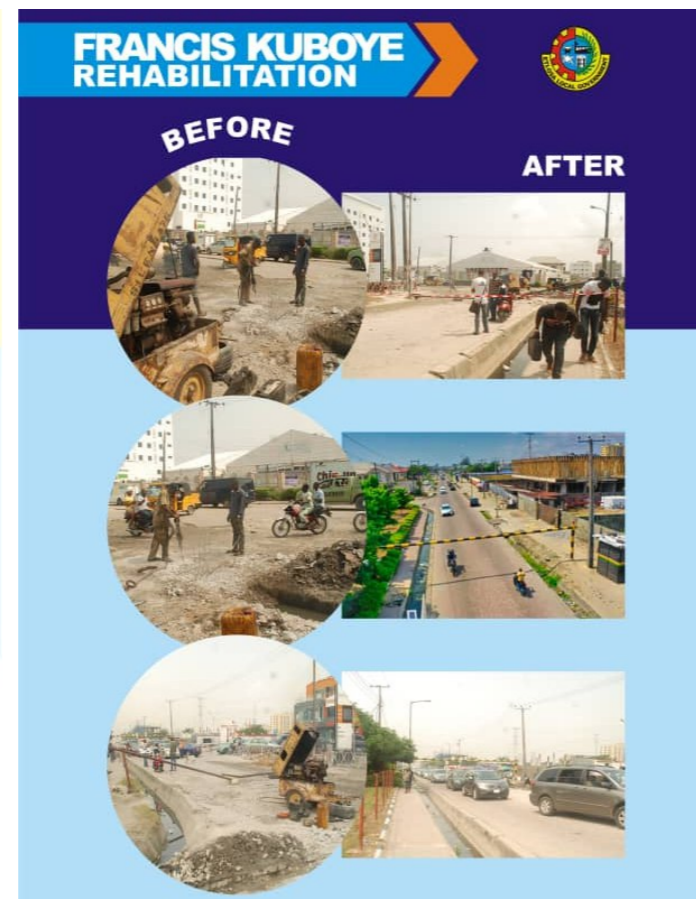
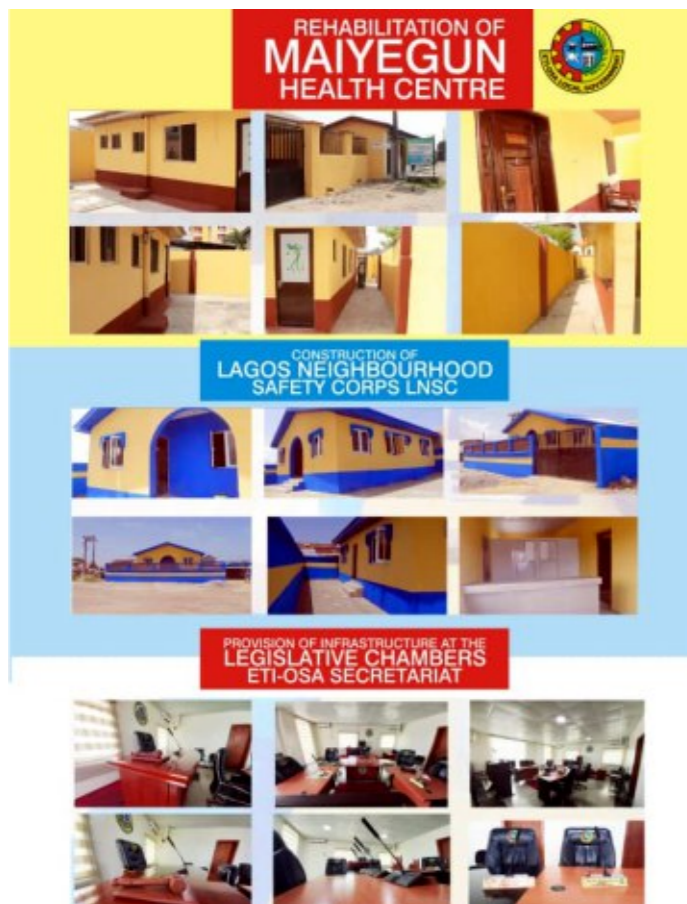


## HRM Oba (Barr.) Babatunde Jemilehin Marks Two Years On The Throne Amid Pomp And Pageantry

# Ogene Igbo sets agenda for Soludo ahead of March 17 inauguration

Convener of All Anambra Media Practitioners Conference and National President of Association of Digital Media Core Advocates (ADMCA), advised the incoming Governor of Anambra State, Prof Chukwuma Charles Soludo, to focus on infrastructural development and security, among others, as priority.

Dr. Chuma-Odili, popularly known as Ogene Igbo, set the agenda on Tuesday while commenting of the March 17, 2022 swearing-in of Soludo, who last November 9 emerged as the sixth democratically elected governor of Anambra.

Speaking on security, Dr. Chuma explained that Anambra, being a leading commercial city in Southeast Nigeria, must have adequate arrangement to strengthen the state security architecture already put in place by Obiano.

He said: "He (Soludo) must embark on acquisition of the modern advanced security apparatus to empower the security arm of the state. These would enhance proper tracking of any criminal related activities in the state. Likewise, he should partner with the media to ensure adequate sensitisation of the dwellers in the area of security and others.

"I am advocating this because I know that all eyes are on Prof Soludo, Ndi Anambra are seriously awaiting him, and I believe this is one of the reasons why they pulled their weight behind him during the election. I'm not expecting anything from Prof Soludo's administration than fulfillment of its manifesto. Now is when to transform his promises to action. Going by his agenda, we are all expecting him to transform his promises into reality."

According to Dr. Chuma-Odili, all that Ndi Anambra want to see is the fulfillment of all those promises made by Soludo. "Prof Soludo promised to fight corruption, ensure security, jobs creation, and others. Let us be patient to watch him accountably based on his promises in the campaign, now is the time to fulfill them," he said.

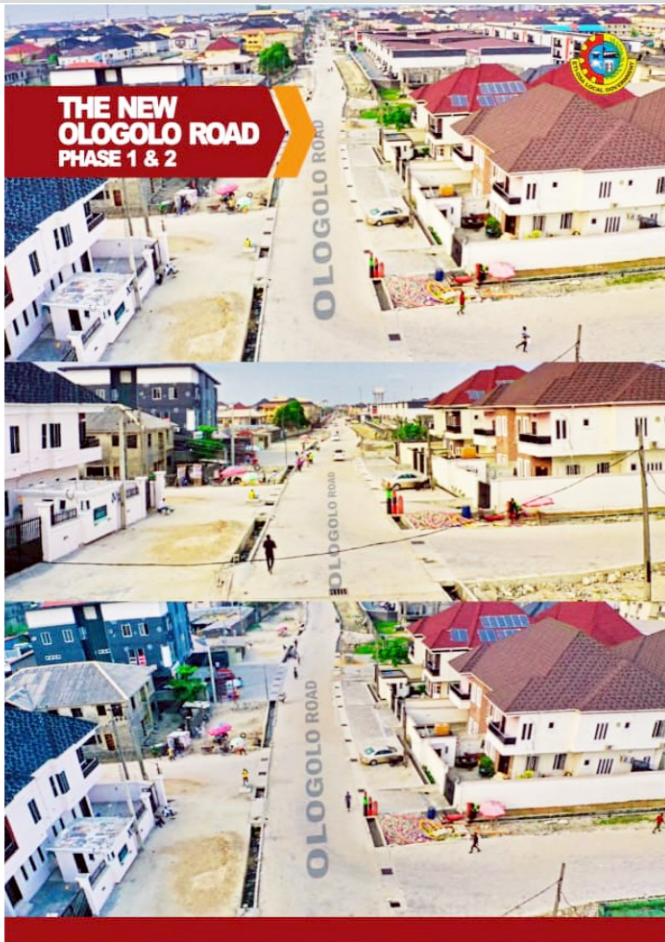
Meanwhile, stakeholders in Anambra online media have begun to express their minds on what should be embedded in the incoming governor's agenda of operation in relation to the interest of their people. According to some of them, priority should be given to making the state more homely, positing that

their contributions to the state's development cannot be over-emphasised. Along this line, Chuma-Odili disclosed that, "come February 18, 2022, in the capital City Awka, a full-blown media event has been fixed specially designed to set agenda for the incoming governor." He said that the event tagged "All Anambra Media Practitioners Conference, AMPC" will be hosted by ADMCA in collaboration with AIMS, and covered by dozens of

journalists both print and electronic. "The Soludo administration is expected to leverage on the communicate that will be raised at the media conference, and bring more dividends of democracy to Ndi Anambra. Expectedly, being a product of the system, Soludo is expected to hit the ground running, as Ndi Anambra will not entertain any excuse for under performance," Chuma-Odili said.

# NIGERIA CALLS FOR MORE AFRICAN COLLABORATION TO FIGHT PUBLIC HEALTH CHALLENGES, CLIMATE CHANGE

*VP receives ICAN delegation, commends new framework for public finance management*

Nigeria has called for greater collaboration among Africans in order to more effectively confront challenges such as those in climate change, public health such as local vaccine production among others. President Muhammadu Buhari made the call today at a meeting of the African Union on the New Partnership for African Development, NEPAD under the auspices of the 39th Session of the NEPAD Heads of State and Government Orientation Committee (HSGOC), at the margins of the 35th Ordinary Session of the African Union. Represented by Vice President Yemi Osinbajo, SAN, at the virtual event, the President said the continent needs “to prepare itself more for intra African collaboration to fight public health challenges, work together to promote vaccine production in Africa, and prompt response to climate change and the zero-emissions targets.”

According to the President, “the Covid19 pandemic has severely weakened our economies but it has also left important lessons. One is that Africa needs to prepare itself more for intra African collaboration to fight public health challenges, especially those of pandemic scale.

“We must work together to promote vaccine production in Africa. Second issue I would like to raise is Africa’s response to climate change and the zero-emissions targets set in Paris and at subsequent climate change meetings.

“We must of course contribute our quota in protecting the environment and preventing climate change. But we must also continue to build sustainable power systems to accelerate development and create economic opportunities for our people.”

Speaking further about Climate Change, the President said “we need far more energy than the renewables sources can immediately provide. Therefore, we cannot but adopt gas as a transition fuel.

“We must together make clear to the developed world that the current trend of

withholding funds for investment in gas development is the wrong thing to do at this time.”

Reporting on the success made by Nigeria in domesticating the NEPAD framework on sustainable development, President Buhari noted that “growth in the Nigerian ICT sector has been phenomenal. Indeed, ICT recorded the highest growth of all the sectors of the Nigerian economy in 2020.”

“By intensifying Agricultural development, NEPAD inspired Home Grown School Feeding and other Social Intervention Programmes, we are feeding over nine million children in public schools daily and significantly improving the lot of our people.

“It is worthy of note that through regional partnership, Nigeria is currently implementing the innovative strengthening of smallholder farmer’s capabilities towards productive land restoration amid COVID-19 in Nigeria.”

“This is not only to cushion the effect of COVID-19 in the country but also to accelerate the implementation of Africa’s regional initiative to restore degraded lands,” the President added.

While commending the foresight of the founding Fathers of NEPAD, AU’s development agency and the continental initiative for the effective implementation of Agenda 2063, Buhari re-echoed the view that “NEPAD is about the development of our continent – delivering to African citizens. Let us look forward to working together in building a strong organisation for delivery of results on the continent.”

Meanwhile, Vice President Yemi Osinbajo, SAN had earlier received a delegation from the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Nigeria (ICAN) led by its President, Mrs Comfort Eytayo, on a courtesy visit to the Presidential Villa.

The Vice President commended the adoption of the new, innovative framework for public finance management known as the ICAN-AI (ICAN Accountability Index) and noted the proposed amendment to the Act establishing the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Nigeria (ICAN).

Prof. Osinbajo believes that the ICAN Accountability Index will improve transparency and accountability in public finance management in Nigeria. Said he “your public financial management efforts with the ICAN AI is an important innovation and initiative especially because what has happened in the past was that we were generally accessed for transparency, accountability and all of that by different systems that were usually foreign.”

“This (ICAN AI) is something that at least will give us our own local content to these kinds of assessment. It is something that we all need to support. I will do all I can to support the innovation,” the Vice President added.

The Vice President expressed delight with the progress of the accounting body.

“I am personally very happy to see that ICAN has grown from strength to strength, and I am particularly fascinated by some of what we are seeing especially forays into public education,” in reference to the idea of ‘ICAN on air.’

Recalling his ties with the accounting body as an examiner and lecturer over the years, the VP hoped that the proposed amendment to the Act establishing the institute would further advance the cause of public finance management as well as accounting practice in the country.

In her remarks, Mrs Eytayo praised the Federal Government’s “consistent drive to revamp the country’s budget system, aligning with international best practice of having a January to December budget year and having Finance Acts to make the Appropriation Act more realizable.”

Other ICAN officials present at the meeting were former President of the Institute, Sen. Kolawole Bajomo; ICAN Vice President, Mr Tijani Musa Isa, and Registrar of the Institute, Prof Ahmed Kumshe, among others.

## FG Commits N362.557 billion To Funding Key Road Projects Through Sukuk - N250 billion Symbolic Cheque Presented To Implementing Ministries

The Federal Government has committed, through the Federal Ministry of Works and Housing (FMWH), a total sum of N362.557 billion from 2017 to date to the funding of key road projects through Sukuk, according to Mrs. Zainab Ahmed, Honourable Minister of Finance, Budget and National Planning. In her remarks at the recent symbolic cheque presentation ceremony of 2021 sovereign sukuk issue proceeds of N250 billion to the implementing ministries in Abuja, Mrs. Ahmed noted that the symbolic cheque presentation ceremony, which started in 2017, is the fourth in the series. "So far, we have committed, through the Federal Ministry of Works and Housing (FMWH), a total sum of N362.557 billion from 2017 to date to the funding of key road projects through Sukuk," she said. "In view of the significant milestones recorded in the use of Sukuk funds to reconstruct and rehabilitate our road infrastructure, which evidence is visible for all to see, the government decided to incorporate other Ministries with critical road projects into the Sukuk funding structure. "Today, we have the Federal Capital

Territory Administration (FCTA) and Ministry of Niger Delta Affairs (MNDA) joining us. According to her, the three Ministries (FMWH, FCTA and MNDA) will be sharing the Sukuk Issue Proceeds of N250 billion, which was successfully issued by the Debt Management Office (DMO) on behalf of the federal government on December 29, 2021

as follows: FMW & H – N210,565,000,000.00; FCTA – N29,000,000,000.00; and MNDA – N10,435,000,000.00. "The 2021 N250 billion will be released as part of the capital expenditure in the 2021 Appropriation Act, which has been extended by the National Assembly to March 31, 2022. "As at November 2021, N3.40 trillion had been expended for capital, which represents over 74 percent performance when compared to the total capital budget of N4.569 trillion. Out of the N3.40 trillion so released, N2.98 trillion represents 83 percent of the provision for ministries, departments and agencies (MDAs) capital, N369.9 billion for multi-lateral/bilateral project-tied loans, and N49.52 billion as government owned enterprises (GOEs) capital expenditure. The government, according to her, will continue to prioritise spending on critical infrastructure in order to sustain the momentum on gross domestic product (GDP) growth. As you may be aware, the GDP is projected to grow by 4.20 percent in 2022. This can only be possible through steady increase in spending on critical infrastructure, such as roads. Mrs. Ahmed congratulated the DMO for the introduction of the Sovereign Sukuk and for the successes recorded in raising the funds through the product, which now stands at a total sum of N612.557 billion.

## CRIME: How 4 Teenagers Slaughtered Friend's Lover For 'Money Ritual' In Ogun

It was a story of grief and anger in Ogun State on Saturday as four teenagers gruesomely murdered a female friend of one of them for a money-making ritual purpose in Adatan area of Abeokuta metropolis, the state capital.

The teenagers, identified as 17-year-old Wariz Oladehinde; 19-year-old Abdulgafar Lukman, and Mustakeem Balogun, 20, strangled the girl, simply identified as Rofiat, to death, severed off her head and genital before packing her remains in a sack, which they dumped at an abandoned building in the area.

After succeeding at severing her head and genitals, the four friends: Wariz, Lukman, Mustakeem and the victim's lover, identified as Soliu, thereafter put the human parts into a local pot and started burning it.

Secret of their heinous crime got leaked when a leader of the community's security guards informed the police at Adatan Divisional headquarters that the suspects were burning objects suspected to be human head in a local pot.

The Ogun State Police Command's Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Abimbola Oyeyemi, who confirmed the incident to journalists in Abeokuta on Saturday, said the suspects were arrested following the report lodged with the police at Adatan Divisional headquarters.

"On interrogation, the arrested suspects confessed that what they were burning in the local pot is the head of the girlfriend of their escaped accomplice.

"They confessed further that the girl who was simply identified as Rofiat was lured by her boyfriend simply identified as Soliu to where she was murdered by four of them, after which they severed off her head and packed the remains in a sack which they dumped in an old building," the PPRO said.

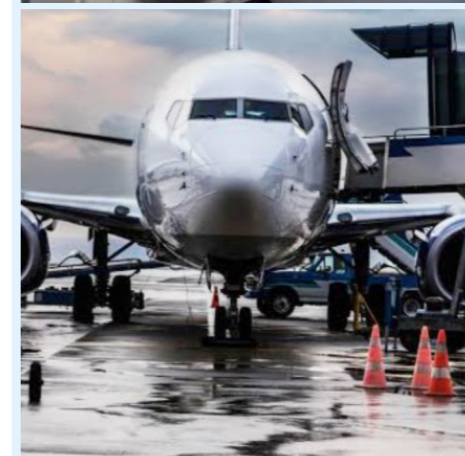
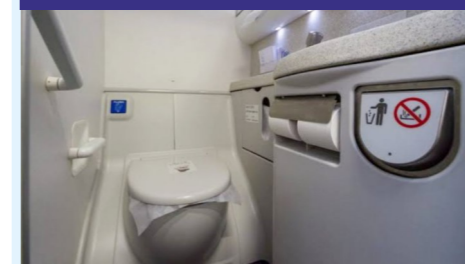
Also in the confessional video recording made by the police, one of the suspects subsequently led police operatives to the building, where Rofiat's dismembered body was recovered along with the short cutlass and a knife used in cutting off her head.



Oyeyemi, however, explained that the State's Commissioner of Police, 'Lanre Bankole, has ordered that the suspects be immediately transferred to the Homicide Section of the State Criminal Investigation and Intelligence Department (SCIID) for discreet investigation "with the view to arraign

them in court as soon as possible." "Following the matching order given to the DPO Adatan by the Commissioner of Police to ensure the arrest of the deceased's boyfriend, the DPO and his men had eventually arrested the fleeing suspect Soliu Majekodumi in his hideout. He is 18 years old".

Have you ever wondered what happens when you flush the toilet in an aeroplane? Well I will explain for you.

This is why you have to close the toilet in the airplane before you flush, the vacuum does all the work taking in little water 2 liters of water compared to 6-19liters normal toilet uses. Aside using very little water, vacuum toilet can flush in any direction and can be put anywhere in a building.

# Home Coming: Dr. Ibijoke Sanwo-Olu Unveils Shomolu Ultra-Modern Healthcare Facility

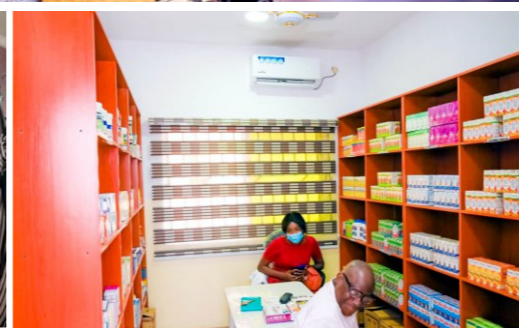
